This position requires promptness and personal time management in serving others. Having all equipment and personal belongings organized and ready for punctual start is an expectation. One who will serve athletes & parents with an understanding and appreciation for the age emotional level kids ages 5-7. Ability to support and engage the athlete's families.</p>
