

THE NEW SWIX Merino Roto Fleece! Item number- T18W

New to the SWIX Brush program is the specially designed, Merino wool brush for cold application of waxes.



After finishing with a hand brush, residue from hard wax can remain in the lowest points of the structure, this remaining wax can grab small, sharp snow crystals and create what is known as dry friction.

The natural wool material generates greater heat and has excellent elasticity, allowing it to conform to the peaks and valleys of the base structure.

The roto wool removes any excess wax that may have settled at the bottom of each structure, while properly coating the structure. Allowing for maximum glide in cold conditions.

This new method of applying cold waxes has seen incredible results in our testing and is now the most popular application method on the World Cup today for cold/hard top-coat waxes (4-5-6 category).

- The method is tailor-made for harder waxes, such as the Marathon Black, Marathon White and the colder waxes in the new Pro Non-Fluorinated System.
- Wax is applied onto the skis in two simple steps: Start by applying the wax to the roto wool by touching the wax to the wool for a few seconds while running the drill at a speed of approx. 1.500 RPM.
- Then, use the roto brush on the base with a speed of approx. 1.500 RPM, making X3 passes.
- Use light pressure.
- Finish with a clean, polishing Merino Wool Roto Fleece, X3 passes.
